This is a 3-story, multiple-bay commercial building in the Classical Revival style with Beaux Arts/Neo-Classical influences built in 1939. The structural system is frame. The foundation is undetermined. Exterior walls are original brick. The building has a low side gable roof clad in original asphalt shingles. Windows are original steel, 1-light fixed. Multiple expansions and outbuildings on a landscaped lot.
