**Description/Remarks**

This is a 1-story duplex built in 1960. The building is rectangular in plan. Exterior walls are original brick. The building has a low hip roof clad in replacement asphalt shingles. Windows are original wood, 1/1 double-hung sashes. There is a single-story, full-span veranda characterized by an integrated (under the main) roof clad in asphalt shingles with ornate decorative metal posts.
