This is a 2-story single-family residence in the Colonial Revival style. The building is square in plan. The structural system is masonry. The foundation is stone. Exterior walls are original brick and original brick. The building has a medium hip roof clad in modern asphalt shingles and two gabled dormers. There is one center, rear slope, brick chimney. Windows are modern vinyl, 1/1 double-hung sashes. There is a single-story, single-bay central open porch characterized by a flat roof with turned wood posts.
