Description/Remarks

This is a 1.5-story domestic building in the Vernacular style built ca. 1860. The foundation is poured concrete, not visible. Exterior walls are vinyl siding. The building has a side-gable roof clad in asphalt shingles. Windows are contemporary vinyl 1/1 double-or-single hung. The porch is original or historic, Full- Width, One-Story; Wood materials; Deck roof; Classical supports. Doors are contemporary metal glazed, paneled.
