This is a 1-story, 3-bay house in the No Academic Style built in 1946. The building is rectangular in plan. The structural system is frame. Exterior walls are weatherboard. The building has a low side gable roof clad in asphalt shingles and gabled dormers. Diminutive gable-roofed extension on east. Large, historic rear ell addition under hipped roof. Windows are original wood, 6/6 double-hung sashes, paired.
