Description/Remarks

This is a 2-story single-family residence in the Italianate style built ca. 1885. The structural system is frame. The foundation is stone. Exterior walls are original wood siding. The building has a low hip roof clad in replacement asphalt shingles and brackets. Windows are historic wood, 1/1 double-hung sashes. There is a single-story, wrap-around open porch characterized by a hip roof clad in asphalt shingles with square wood posts. Double wood doors with single transom window above. There is a two-story, rear, frame addition. Two-story box bay on south.
