Description/Remarks

This is a 1.5-story single-family residence in the Folk/Traditional style built ca. 1875. The structural system is frame. Exterior walls are modern vinyl siding and original brick. Rear brick addition. The building has a low front gable roof clad in replacement asphalt shingles. There is one center, straddle ridge, brick chimney. Windows are replacement vinyl, 1/1 double-hung sashes. There is a single-story, single-bay open porch characterized by a gabled roof clad in asphalt shingles with round wood posts. There is a single-story, rear, brick addition. Incompatible.
