**Description/Remarks**

This is a 1.5-story single-family residence in the Folk/Traditional style built ca. 1900. The building is rectangular in plan. The structural system is box frame. The foundation is concrete block. Exterior walls are modern vinyl siding. The building has a gable roof clad in replacement asphalt shingles. Windows are historic wood, 1/1 double-hung sashes. Front porch carpeted with metal supports. Shed dormer additions with vinyl windows. Metal storm windows.
