Description/Remarks

This is a 1-story single-family residence in the Craftsman style built in 1922. The building is rectangular in plan. The structural system is box frame. The foundation is concrete block. Exterior walls are original wood siding. The building has a gable roof clad in replacement asphalt shingles. Windows are original wood, 6/1 double-hung sashes. There is a single-story, partial-width open porch characterized by a gabled roof clad in asphalt shingles with square posts. Arched porch openings. Wider board siding below first floor windows, narrow siding above. Rafter tails extend from front porch. Alum soffits.
