**Description/Remarks**

This is a 2-story single-family residence in the Prairie School style built in 1913. The building is rectangular in plan. The structural system is masonry. The foundation is stone. Exterior walls are original stucco. The building has a hip roof clad in replacement asphalt shingles and one shed-roofed dormer. Windows are original wood, 1/1 double-hung sashes. There is a single-story, full-width open porch characterized by a hip roof clad in asphalt shingles with round wood posts. Front porch metal stair railings. Aluminum storm windows. Very intact.
