Description/Remarks

This is a 2-story single-family residence in the Craftsman style built in 1913. The structural system is masonry. The foundation is stone. Exterior walls are original stucco. The building has a gable roof clad in replacement asphalt shingles. There is one side right, side slope, brick chimney. Windows are original wood, 1/1 double-hung sashes. Wood storm windows. Multi-paned casements in side wing. There is a platform/stoop. On a side elevation is a two-story enclosed porch. On the front is a two-story projecting bay. Behind the house is a two-story garage of undetermined date.
