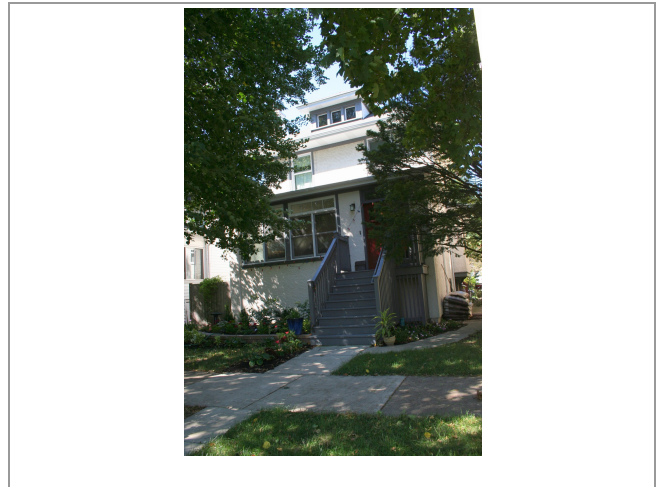

**Description/Remarks**

This is a 2-story single-family residence in the Craftsman style built in 1915. The structural system is frame. The foundation is raised. Exterior walls are original stucco. The building has a medium hip roof clad in replacement asphalt shingles with box cornice and one hip-roofed dormer. There is one side left, exterior, stuccoed chimney. Windows are original wood, 1/1 double-hung sashes. There is a single-story, full-span enclosed porch characterized by a hip roof clad in asphalt shingles with square stuccoed posts.
