Description/Remarks

This is a 2.5-story single-family residence in the Prairie School style built in 1922. The structural system is frame/stucco. Exterior walls are original stucco. The building has a hip roof clad in asphalt shingles and one hip-roofed dormer. There is one side gable, exterior, brick and stucco chimney. Windows are original wood, 1/1 double-hung sashes. There is a single-story, single-bay open porch characterized by a hip roof clad in asphalt shingles with square stuccoed posts on side walls stuccoed piers. Side entry porch.
