Description/Remarks

This is a 2.5-story single-family residence in the Queen Anne style built in 1904. The structural system is frame. The foundation is stone. Exterior walls are original wood clapboard. The building has a hip roof clad in replacement asphalt shingles. There is one center, flat roof, brick chimney. Windows are historic wood, 1/1 double-hung sashes. There is a single-story, full-width open porch characterized by a hip roof clad in asphalt shingles with round wood posts. There is a single-story, side, frame addition. Sun porch addition.
