Description/Remarks

This is a 2-story single-family residence in the Vernacular style built in 1909. The structural system is frame. The foundation is concrete block. Exterior walls are modern vinyl siding. The building has a gable front roof clad in replacement asphalt shingles. Windows are replacement vinyl, 1/1 double-hung sashes. There is a single-story, full-width open porch characterized by a hip roof clad in asphalt shingles with round wood posts. There is a two-story, rear, frame addition. Residential.
