Description/Remarks

This is a 1.5-story single-family residence built in 1921. The structural system is masonry. The foundation is raised. Exterior walls are original brick. The building has a medium hip roof clad in replacement asphalt shingles with box cornice and one hip-roofed dormer. There are two side left, exterior, brick chimneys. Windows are original wood, 1/1 double-hung sashes. There is a single-story, full-span enclosed recessed porch with square brick posts. The house is characterized by the diamond-patterned windows of the enclosed porch and the square and diamond-shaped stone panels on the front facade. The dormer has original vertical three-light casement or awning windows.
