Description/Remarks

This is a 2-story single-family residence in the Prairie style built in 1919. The structural system is frame. Exterior walls are stucco. The building has a hip roof clad in asphalt shingles with deep. Windows are wood, 1/1 double-hung sashes. The enclosed front porch is accessed only from the interior and does not feature any exterior doors. The front door is located within a covered front stoop on the right side elevation. The stoop features a small hip roof clad in asphalt shingles, square post supports, and stucco knee walls.
