**Description/Remarks**

This is a 2-story single-family residence in the Contemporary style built in 2006. The building is rectangular in plan. The structural system is frame. The foundation is undetermined. Exterior walls are original cementitious/hardy plank siding. The building has a medium hip roof clad in original asphalt shingles with box cornice and one hip-roofed dormer. Windows are original vinyl, 1/1 double-hung sashes. There is a single-story, full-span open porch characterized by a hip roof clad in asphalt shingles with square wood posts.
