Description/Remarks

This is a 2-story single-family residence in the Craftsman style built in 1913. The structural system is frame. The foundation is undetermined. Exterior walls are original stucco and replacement asphalt shingles. The building has a hip and gable roof clad in replacement asphalt shingles with box cornice. Windows are original wood, multi-light casements. Also 1-over-1 double-hung sashes. 2003 permit to replace 18 windows. There is a single-story, single-bay recessed porch characterized by a hip roof clad in asphalt shingles on square stuccoed piers.
