Description/Remarks

This is a 1.5-story single-family residence in the Colonial Revival style built in 1922. The structural system is masonry. The foundation is poured concrete. Exterior walls are original stucco. The building has a gable roof clad in replacement asphalt shingles. Windows are , 10-light double-hung sashes. There is a platform/stoop. Two enclosed windows east side. Classical wood front door surround. Wood brackets in eaves.
