Description/Remarks

This is a 2-story single-family residence in the Prairie School style built in 1913. The structural system is masonry. The foundation is stone. Exterior walls are original stucco. The building has a hip roof clad in replacement asphalt shingles and one shed-roofed dormer. Windows are original wood, 1/1 double-hung sashes. There is a single-story, full-width open porch characterized by a hip roof clad in asphalt shingles with round wood posts. Front porch metal stair railings. Aluminum storm windows. Very intact.
