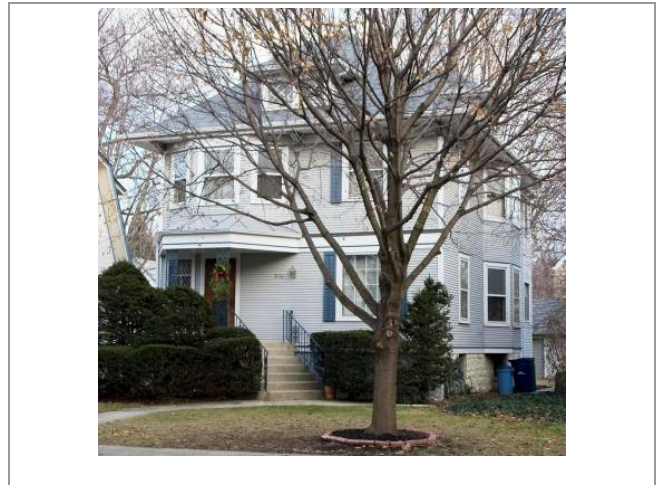

**Description/Remarks**

This is a 2-story single-family residence in the Queen Anne style built ca. 1910. The building is square in plan. The structural system is frame. The foundation is stone. Exterior walls are original clapboard. The building has a hip roof clad in replacement asphalt shingles. Windows are , 2-light double-hung sashes. There is a single-story platform/stoop characterized by a hip roof clad in asphalt shingles. Front porch material is concrete. There is a 1957 front alteration to a two-apartment building.
