**Description/Remarks**

This is a 2.5-story single-family residence in the Queen Anne style built ca. 1890. The building is rectangular in plan. The structural system is box frame. The foundation is stone. Exterior walls are original wood siding and original wood shingles. The building has a gable roof clad in replacement asphalt shingles. Windows are , 2-light double-hung sashes. There is a single-story enclosed porch characterized by a hip roof clad in asphalt shingles with square posts. Porch material is wood. Asbestos siding has been added and the front windows replaced since this building's original construction.
