Description/Remarks

This is a 1.5-story single-family residence in the Craftsman style built in 1919. The structural system is frame. The foundation is raised brick. Exterior walls are replacement wood siding. The building has a medium side gable roof clad in replacement asphalt shingles with raked box cornice and brackets and one gabled dormer. Windows are replacement wood, 1/1 double-hung sashes. There is a single-story, full-span enclosed porch with square brick posts. The gable dormer has exposed rafter tails and the cladding on the side gable appears to be replacement vinyl.
