This is a 1-story commercial building built in the period 1900-1909. The building is rectangular in plan. The structural system is masonry. The foundation is stone. Exterior walls are original brick. The building has a flat roof clad in replacement rubberized/asphalt composite with box cornice. Windows are replacement wood, 6/6 double-hung sashes. A side wing was added to the library.
