This is a 1-story, 3-bay commercial building in the 20th Century Commercial style built in the period 1950-1959. The building is rectangular in plan. The structural system is frame. The foundation is poured concrete. Exterior walls are historic stone veneer and modern vinyl siding. Behind the facade, which comprises a historic storefront, the building appears to be modern construction. The building has a gable roof clad in modern asphalt shingles. Windows are replacement, 1-light fixed. The building has an inset storefront with two display panes over stone veneer bulkheads flanking a central, single-entry door.
