This is a 2-story, 3-bay commercial building in the Art Moderne style built after 1944. The building is rectangular in plan. The structural system is masonry. The foundation is continuous brick. Exterior walls are original brick. The building has a flat roof clad in modern rubberized/asphalt composite with flush cornice. Windows are historic wood, 1/1 double-hung sashes. The storefront design and materials have been altered and no longer reflect the original. Distinguished by the twin outset stone bands at the cornice and the unusual 'stepped-up' massing on the west front elevation. Storefront was reconfigured with new materials and design..
