This is a 2-story, 7-bay post office in the Federal style with 20th Century Commercial influences built in 1928. The structural system is masonry. The foundation is continuous brick. Exterior walls are original brick. The building has a flat roof clad in modern rubberized/asphalt composite. The cornice is a distinctive patterned stone. Windows are replacement wood, 12/12 double-hung sashes.
