This is a 1-story domestic building in the Bungalow/craftsman style built in the period 1930-1939. The building is square in plan. The structural system is frame. The foundation is undetermined. Exterior walls are replacement stucco. The building has a pyramidal roof clad in replacement asphalt shingles with raked open cornice. There is an internal central brick chimney. Windows are original wood, 3/1 double-hung sashes. The front entrances are characterized by porch roofs with arched supports.
